This is a reconstruction of two sixteenth-century ornamental borders. I have added an additional piece to the second design (Granjon's arabesques) so that the corners can be completed.

This is an OpenType font. It should work properly on Linux, Macintosh and Windows computers.

Use

1. The pieces of the first border are on the lower-case letter keys. To create lines, type:

abcd efgh

or

qabcdr sefght

For vertical lines type:

i	j
k	l
m	n
o	p

2. The pieces of the second border are on the capital letter keys. To create a complete pattern, type:

EFABCDEFABCD	
SUGHIJKLGHVR	
MG	HN
OD	EP
QR	ST
HN	MG
EP	OD
ST	QR
MG	HN
OD	EP
QWDEFABCDEXT	
HIJKLGHIIJKLG	

Of course you can combine the various units in other ways also, just as the old printers did.
