

Cló dubh (*textura quadrata*) is ea Germanica a bunaíodh go príomha ar an gcló a d'úsáid Fust agus Schöffer sa blíain 1457. Ar an láimh eile de, bunaíodh na ceannlitreacha go príomha orthu siúd sa chéad chló ag Gutenberg (c. 1455), atá níos slachtmhaire agus níos comhsheasmhai.

Rinne mé an cló seo i dtosach báire toisc go raibh cló oiriúnach de dhíth orm chun samplaí as lámhscríbhinní a thrascróbh, agus ar an ábhar sin cuimsíonn sé roinnt nasclitreacha agus noda. (Má tá tuilleadh caractar den chineál sin de dhíth ort beidh mé lánsásta iad a chur leis.)

Tá an cló seo á dháileadh saor in aisce, ceadaítear é a úsáid gan bhac, agus ceadaítear é a chóipeáil agus a dháileadh a thuilleadh. Fanann an cóipcheart, áfach, leis an té a chruthaigh é, agus dáltear é faoi réir na gcoinníollacha seo a leanas: nach ndéanfaidh tú an cló a athrú ar bhealach ar bith, ná a athainmníu; nach ndéanfaidh tú iarracht ar íocaíocht ar bith a fháil air; agus nach dtairgfidh tú é i leith is gur d'obair féin nó obair aon duine eile é seachas an té a chruthaigh é.

Germanica is a blackletter (*textura quadrata*) type based mainly on the one used by Fust and Schöffer in 1457. The capital letters, on the other hand, are based mainly on those of the first Gutenberg type (c. 1455), which are neater and more consistent.

I made this font in the first instance because I needed a suitable type for transcribing examples from manuscripts, and for that reason it includes a number of ligatures and scribal abbreviations. (If you have a need for additional characters of this kind I will be happy to add them.)

This font is distributed free of charge, may be used freely, and may be copied and further circulated. The copyright, however, remains with the person who created it, and it is distributed on the following conditions: that you will not alter the font in any way, or rename it; that you will not attempt to obtain payment for it; and that you will not pass it off as your own work or the work of anyone other than the person who created it.
